4. Eligibility for participation is strictly for the first, second and third prize winners of single items and first and second

prize winners of Group items of the Regional Sports meet 2024.

- 6. Participants shall compete ONLY in their respective age category. Age proof: Organizers shall hold the right to verify the registrant's age wherever necessary. All participants are hereby informed to carry an age verification document as proof of their entries. This proof may have to be shown at the chest number desk. Random checks will be carried out and chest numbers will not be allotted in case of any failure to provide the age proof. The responsibility will solely rest on the participants or their parents/guardians.
- 7. Registration fee: £5/- for each entry. £12/- per person to enter three items. £16/- for a relay team. £75/- per team for tug of war.
  - \*(The entry fees mentioned above is for the National Sports. Regional committee could able to decide the entry fees for regional sports events. Please check with the respective regional committee)
- 8. Registration along with issuing of Chest Numbers will start at 10 am. Latecomers will not be entertained.
- 9. The registration fee shall be paid by the Association representative and individual payments will not be accepted at the registration desk.
- 10. Medals and Certificates will be awarded to winners. Besides Overall Champions Trophy, Individual Champions Trophy for best individual performances in each category (Kids, Sub-juniors, Juniors, Seniors, Adults, Senior Adults and Super seniors) will be awarded.
- 11. Decisions by the Judges will be final.
- 12. For any dispute regarding the final results, Association President/ Secretary can approach the Appeal Committee. Individual appeals will not be entertained.
- 13. Shoes must be worn by all participants.
- 14. Tug of War will be conducted on a knock-out basis. Maximum body weight of each team (7pullers) shall not exceed 620 kgs. No spikes or football trainers shall be worn by the tug of war participants.
- 15. Participants will be responsible for their Health and Safety. Parents will be responsible for their children under the age of 16 years.

- 16. Every participating Association must have at least one First Aider along with them and must inform his/her details to the Organizing Committee prior to the opening ceremony.
- **17.** All associations should bring their association banners, flag etc. to be displayed during the inaugural assembly and parade.
- 18. Food stall will be available at the venue and food can be bought at a reasonable price.
- 19. We follow no alcohol & no drug policy during the event strictly. The event will be notified to the local Police Authorities to curb any antisocial behaviour.
- 20. Participants can only compete in a maximum of either two tracks and one field or two fields and one track in total three events individually excluding group items.
